

PURPOSE OF FORM: A Member of the House may file a complaint against another Member of the House for an alleged violation of a House statute or a common law that directly impacts the person filing this complaint. All questions are required to be answered and this complaint must be filed within 180 days of the alleged violation occurring. In addition, you cannot file a civil complaint if a criminal complaint has already been filed for the same violation.
