



CRIMINAL COMPLAINT

Pursuant to HCC § 2-2-8

PURPOSE OF FORM: An authorized party shall file a complaint against a Member of the House, following the issue of a ticket, if the Member has allegedly violated a House statute, common law, or a Rule of the House that is within the concern of the House as a whole. The authorized party should be aware:

- A criminal complaint cannot be filed if the Sergeant-at-Arms nor the Speaker saw the alleged violation occur
- A Member cannot receive a duplicate civil and criminal complaint for the same allegations
- A criminal complaint can only be filed within 180 days after the alleged violation or 180 after finding out about the alleged violation
